

## resorting HAZARDS.

Work safety starts with YOU. If you spot ANY workplace hazard, report it to your supervisor. Here's six common ones:

- Poor Housekeeping & Workplace Congestion Including spills, objects in the walkway, other slip/fall hazards.
- Chemical Hazards or Spills

  Detect a chemical hazard by smell, irritation or sight? Report it!
- Ergonomic Hazards

  If a work task risks injury to the musculoskeletal system (lifting, repetition, awkward motions), it MAY be an ergonomic hazard.
- Inadequate Control of Hazardous Energy
  If there are Machine Guards, Tags or Locks that are missing,
  damaged or insufficient to warn you of their power report it!
- Defective Equipment or PPE

  If any tools, ladders, machinery don't work properly or if PPE provided does not protect you effectively tell your supervisor!
- Lack of Training

  Request safety training on unfamiliar equipment or materials!
