

Wearing Your Don E. P. E.



When hands are exposed to hazards like skin absorption of harmful substances, cuts/lacerations, punctures, burns or temperature extremes.



When there is danger of head injuries from impact, falling/flying objects, or electrical burns.



When exposed to chemical, radiological or mechanical irritants or hazards, including sprays, abrasive airborne particles (wood/metal), etc.



When in danger of foot injuries due to working near heavy objects that could fall or roll onto feet.



When air may be contaminated with harmful or toxic dusts, fumes, smoke, vapors, sprays, etc.

When working near loud noises over 85 dB for an 8 hour time-weighted average.
